Fun Facts:

Seed Germination

In the soil, seeds soak up water and wait until it gets warm to start germination.

Once the radicle emerges, the plant grows in the dark and has its stem grow longer, pushing through the soil searching for sunlight at the surface.

When the plant sees sunlight it can start photosynthesis! Taking energy from the sun and carbon dioxide to make sugar and oxygen for us to breathe.

You can tell photosynthesis is happening when the leaves turn green and start expanding.

(You can see this change on Plant Girl's seedling plant on her head)

Fun Facts:

The poppy Plant Girl talked to is the state flower of California, the Golden Poppy.

Did you know?
The spines on a cactus are modified leaves!
They protect the plant and make shade in the sunny dessert!

Carnivorous plants like the Venus Flytrap eat insects as a source of nitrogen allowing them to grow in soil with low nitrogen content.

Coconuts can be considered a seed/fruit/nut.
They disperse and float in the ocean allowing them to move from island to island thanks to their amazing husk that is waterproof!
